BUFFALO & ERIE COUNTY BOTANICAL GARDENS 2655 South Park Ave / Buffalo, NY

Our hands-on plant science programs and accompanying mini-tours of the Botanical Gardens are exciting, informative and tons of fun for students of all ages! Create a terrarium, start a succulent garden, learn about plants we eat, discuss plant reproduction and the parts of plants/flowers, learn about ecosystems and pollution and more.

- Length of tour: varies
- Age: Varying options available. Some programs are aligned for specific grade levels.
- Availability: Year-round, Programs must be reserved and booked at least three weeks in advance.
- Group sizé: 6-100 Meals: Not available. Students may bring bagged lunches. Reserved lunch space available.



BUFFALO MUSEUM OF SCIENCE 1020 Humboldt Parkway / Buffalo, NY

Inspire your student's curiosity by exploring natural sciences through exhibits, interactive science studios, a National geographic 3D cinema, customized workshops and museum tours.

- Length of tour: 60-90 mins
- Age: K-12
- Availability: Year-round (day & evening)
- Group size: 10 +



URBAN AIR ADVENTURE PARK One Walden Galleria, Buffalo, NY

A trampoline park but with a lot more including a ropes course, a Sky Rider coaster, Warrior Course, Battle Beam, rock climbing walls, laser tag, bumper cars and a VR area!

- Age: Grades K-12
- Availability: Open daily
- Group sizé: 10+

NIAGARA POWER PROJECT VISTA 5777 Lewiston Rd / Lewiston, NY

Science center atop the largest dam east of the Mississippi and second largest hydro producer in the nation! Experience New York State's largest hydroelectric generator learning about electricity, geology and discovering STEAM careers through exciting interactive multimedia displays and exhibits, a 4D simulated ride and much more.

- Length of tour: Tailored to needs of 1-4 hours
- Age: All ages
- Availability: Open seven days a week 9am 5pm. Closed Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve & Day, New Year's Eve & Day
- Group size: Up to 200 Meals: Indoor cafeteria and outdoor picnic seating available for catered meals.



SKYZONE 425 Cayuga Road #400 / Cheektowaga, NY

Fun and educational trips. Jump, zip and soar across the sky zone court, play 3-D dodge ball or take a flight in the Foam Zone. Sky marketing program encompasses jumping with brand-building exercises with a competitive presentation to follow. WHIRLPOOL JET BOAT TOURS 115 South Water Street / Lewiston, NY

45 minute guided jet boat tour through the amazing historic sights and class V rapids on the lower Niagara River

- Length of Tour: 45 minutes
- Age: 6+ (minimum height 44") for Wet tour, or 4+ (minimum height 40") for the Dry tour
- Availability: Seasonal, April to October (dry tour schedule may be extended, TBA)
- Group size: Any size · Meals: May be arranged through Water Street Landing next door



NIAGARA JET ADVENTURES 555 Water Street / Youngstown NY

Adventurous and educational White Water Experience! Learn all about the lower Niagara River and it's history while navigating class 3 – 5 white water rapids.

- Length of Tour: 1 hour
- Age: 4+ (minimum 40" tall)
- Availability: All 4 seasons closed when the ice flow hits the River (usually late December end of March)
- Group size: 114 students per hour in the warmer months (May October) & 78 students per hour in the cooler months Meals: Snack bar available, we do work with Hard Rock Café for boxed lunches

HISTORY & HERITAGE



FOREST LAWN 1411 Delaware Avenue / Buffalo, NY

Docent will lead the school group on a walking tour highlighting some of the historical people buried there, cemetery symbolism and cemetery lore. The tours can be designed to include a particular subject that the teacher wants to highlight. A fee of \$5.00 per student is required.

- Length of Tour: 2 hours
- Age: Grades 4-12
- Availability: Year round
- Group size: Up to 20 per guide. If group is larger, more guides are available. Meals: None



BUFFALO DOUBLE DECKER "HANDS ON HISTORY" TOUR Buffalo, NY

Experience this region's rich heritage aboard an authentic British Double Decker bus. Your guide, an Irish police officer from 1880, uses humor and history to bring to life tales of the Underground Railroad, Erie Canal and Grain Silos by taking students to the actual places where history happened.

- Length of Tour: 1-2 hours
- Age: 7+
- Availability: May through October
- Group size: up to 65



BUFFALO & ERIE COUNTY NAVAL & MILITARY PARK One Naval Park Cove / Buffalo, NY

Students will step back in history as they explore the USS Little Rock, USS The Sullivans, and the USS Croaker and learn about the people who served aboard these mighty ships.

- Length of Tour: 2-2.5 hours
- Age: 6+
- Availability: Seasonal; April-October
- Group size: 10-150 Meals: restaurants nearby and boxed lunches available for purchase upon request.



NASH HOUSE MUSEUM 36 Nash Street / Buffalo, NY

Tour of the home of Rev.& Mrs. J. Edward Nash's home and many of their artifacts. We tell the history of the black community in early Buffalo.

- Length of Tour: 1-2 hours
- Age: 7+
- Availability: Year round by appointments. May to November Thursday-Saturday 11:00am to 3:30pm
- Group size: Any size group can be accommodated. Meals: None



BEST OF BUFFALO TOUR Starts in front of City Hall (65 Niagara Square, Buffalo)

This downtown interior / exterior walking tour gives students an overview of Buffalo history, and teaches about prominent architectural buildings and styles, the Erie Canal and the Pan-American Exposition, the history of Niagara and Lafayette Squares, and more.

- Length of Tour: K-2: 60 minutes, 3-12: 90 minutes
- Age: K-12
- Availability: Seasonal (September October, April June)
- Group sizé: min. 5, max. 150 Meals: Lunch may be purchased at nearby downtown restaurants.



FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT'S DARWIN MARTIN HOUSE COMPLEX 125 Jewett Pkwy / Buffalo NY

This program introduces Frank Lloyd Wright's architectural genius in the context of Buffalo's history, concepts of art, math, science and innovation.

- Length of tour: 60-90 mins.
- · Availability: Year-round
- Group size: 20-60



THEODORE ROOSEVELT INAUGURAL NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE 641 Delaware Avenue / Buffalo, NY

A unique place where local and national history intersect. A unique event which still impacts our nation over a century later. A unique and powerful experience that takes you back in time through sight, sound and interaction that are sure to engage, enlighten, and entertain all ages on the legacy of Roosevelt as United States President.

- Length of tour: 1-2 hours depending upon activity and group size
- Age: All ages
- Availability: Year-round
- Group size: maximum 50
- Meals: Space for meals available if reserved. No catering available.



NIAGARA FALLS P.O. Box 773 / Niagara Falls, NY

Tour Niagara Falls State Park including a ride aboard the Maid of the Mist and a walk at the base of the Bridal Veil Falls at the Cave of the Winds.

- Length of tour: Varies
- Age: All ages
- Availability: All attractions: April-October



OLD FORT NIAGARA P.O. Box 169 (102 Morrow Plaza) / Youngstown, NY

Tour an original 18th century fortification and learn about early American history through living history programs. Special offerings include Spy for General Washington and Fall Frontier Days.

- Length of tour: 90 minutes 2 hours- can be customized to suit
- Age: 4th grade and up
- Availability: Year round, seven days.
- Group size: 12-500 Meals: Between Memorial Day and Labor Day.



ANTI-SLAVERY RE-ENACTMENT TOUR: "LIVING HISTORY THEATER"

An educational and immersive experience into 19th century civic protest. The sites serve as 165-year old classrooms with costumed interpreters/actors coming to life, in a setting where the landscape has changed very little! Encounter historical figures including an abolitionist, a former slave and women's right's activist, and visit a Quaker community. Then visit the house museum celebrating President Millard Fillmore's "The Fugitive Slave Law", it's sway in the Underground Railroad and more.

- Length of tour: 4 hours
- Group size: 25+
- Age: All ages
- Availability: Year-round



MILLARD FILLMORE PRESIDENTIAL SITE 24 Shearer Avenue / East Aurora, NY

Tour of the only home built by a president as his honeymoon cottage.

- Length of Tour: 40+ minutes
- Age: 10+
